

PRETTY IN PINK **SUPER EASY SNUGGLY SWEATER**



An easy and timeless classic! Make this delicate cardigan in a weekend with Snuggly DK Fair Isle and Snuggly DK White. Sizes in 9 mos (12 mos, 18 mos, 24 mos) Snuggly DK comes in a variety of flavors so choose from Blue, Pink, whatever your pleasure—great for a girl or a boy!

MATERIALS

2 balls Sirdar Snuggly DK Fair Isle--sample in pink and magenta
1 ball Sirdar Snuggly DK White
Size 6 needle (5 sts to inch)

Pattern Stitch: 4 rows garter in white; 8 rows stockinette in Fair Isle.

BACK

With White, CO 55 (60, 65, 70) sts. Knit 5 rows. Change to Fair Isle, work stockinette stitch for 8 rows. Continue working in pattern stitch outlined above for 5 (6, 6, 7) repeats. BO all stitches.

FRONT (make two mirror panels)

With White, CO 28 (30, 32, 35) sts. Knit 5 rows. Change to Fair Isle, work in stockinette stitch for 8 rows. Continue working in pattern stitch outlined above for 4 (5, 5, 6) repeats. BO 5 (5, 6, 7) sts at neck edge. Continue working in pattern, decreasing 1 stitch at neck edge every other for 7 (7, 8, 9) rows—16 (18, 18, 19) sts remain. Continue working until piece measures same as back. BO.

Pretty in Pink Snuggly Fair Isle Sweater cont'd

SLEEVES (make two)

With Fair Isle, CO 55 (60, 65, 70) sts. Work 10 rows stockinette. Begin working in pattern stitch, decreasing 1 st at each edge, every 4th row. Repeat pattern stitch 3 (3, 4, 5) times. Finish with White garter cuff by knitting an additional 4 rows, BO.

FINISHING

Join shoulder seams, sew in sleeves. Sew up side seams and sleeve seams. Begin making the placettes in white by picking up 3 sts for every 4 rows on the RS facing. Knit back in garter stitch for one row. On the buttonhole side, you will make the desired number of buttonholes as follows. Knit in garter to the designated space. Do 1 YO, then knit the next two sts together. Continue in garter until the next desired hole then repeat. At the end of the row, turn work and continue in garter stitch for 2 rows. BO next row loosely. Repeat on the other front panel, but omit the buttonholes. Collar: Pick up 55 (58, 60, 62) stitches evenly around neck opening. Work 1 x 1 rib for ¾ inch. Work seed stitch for 2 additional inches (or desired length.) BO all collar stitches loosely. Weave in ends and block lightly.
