

# CHLOE'S POM POM PONCHO

*A fun first project that lets the yarn do all the work! Made by our lovely Judy from Boca for her adorable granddaughter Chloe. In this project she used Pom Pom by Filatura di Crosa but any DK weight yarn may be substituted.*



## MATERIALS

2 (3, 3) balls Filatura di Crosa Blue

2 (3, 4) balls Filatura di Crosa Pink

1 (2, 2) ball Laines du Nord Baby Cover Pink

Size 5 needles Gauge: 5 sts = 1 inch pattern to fit 18 mos (24 mos, 36 mos) toddler

Finished rectangle size = 10" x 18" (12" x 20", 14" x 22")

## DIRECTIONS

***MAKE TWO IDENTICAL RECTANGLES.***

With size 5 needles and Blue Pom Pom, CO 50 (60,70) sts. Work in stockinette stitch for 12 rows. Change to Pink Pom Pom and continue in stockinette for another 12 rows.

Continue working in that striped pattern until rectangle reaches 18 (20, 22) inches. BO loosely. To finish, place first piece vertically on table. Place second piece at bottom, horizontally. (This forms an L shape.) Join edges. Fold second piece toward you until the edge of that piece meets the left side of work. Fold first piece toward you until edge meets top of second piece. Join edges. Fringe generously with remaining Pom Pom yarn and Baby Cover yarn. Optional: With Baby Cover, work single crochet around neck opening for stability.
