

JUDY'S CUTE PA-TOOTIE

Materials

One ball Tatamy Tweed Worsted in each lime and pink
Size 7 and 6 circular needles

SIZE: 12 months

With larger needles, cast on 176 sts in pink. Join the round and work in garter stitch in the round (knit one row, purl one row) for 12 rounds. After 12th round, change to lime color and work in stockinette stitch (all knitting while working in the round.) Work until piece measures 8 inches. Next row: K2TOG around (88 sts will remain.)

Shape Bodice: Change to pink and smaller needles and work in 1 x 1 rib for 2 rounds. Divide sts for front and back. Work 44 sts for front, place remaining sts on a stitch holder for the back. Shape armholes by working back and forth in the 1 x 1 rib. BO 1 sts at the beginning of next 2 rows, then dec 1 sts each end every row thereafter 3 times. Work even until bodice measures 2 ½ inches. End on a WS row.

Shape Neck: Work 12 sts across. Join second ball of yarn and BO center 12 sts. Work to end. Working both sides at the same time, dec 1 st at each neck edge every other row 3 times. 9 sts will remain on each side. Work in 1 x 1 rib until bodice measures 5 ½ inches. Make button holes. Rib 4, YO, K2TOG, rib to end. Work rib 3 more rows. BO in rib.

Back is worked the same as the front, just omit buttonholes.

Finish by crocheting lime chain around neckline. Sew on buttons.
