

# **PUFF & STUFF**

## **Little Boy's Cardigan Sweater**



*Worked up in super soft Robin Turner Back to Basics Microwash and Peter Pan Tinkerbell, this easy to knit cardi is completely machine washable and dryer friendly—making everyone a happy camper!  
Pattern for 9 mos (12 mos, 24 mos, 36 mos)*

### **MATERIALS**

2 (3, 3, 4) balls Peter Pan Tinkerbell (color shown 808 White/Blue/Indigo) Color A  
3 (4, 5, 5) balls Robin Turner Back to Basics Microwash in White Color B  
Size 9 needles 5 buttons

**Pattern Stitch= 10 row pattern worked in stockinette stitch**

**B=4 rows**

**A=6 rows**

### **BACK**

With A and size 9 needles, CO 45 (50, 55, 60) sts. Knit 5 rows. Change to B, work in pattern stitch to establish first 10 rows. Repeat pattern stitch 4 (5, 6, 7) times.  
Change to B, work 4 rows in st st. BO loosely.

## **PUFF & STUFF LITTLE BOY'S CARDIGAN**

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#### **FRONTS (make two mirror)**

With A and size 9 needles, CO 22 (25, 27, 30) sts. Knit 5 rows. Change to B, establish first 10 rows of pattern stitch. Repeat pattern stitch 3 (4, 5, 6) times. Continue in pattern with B for 4 more rows. Change to A then BO 4 (5, 5, 6) sts at neck edge. Continue working in pattern, all while dec 2 sts at neck edge every row for 4 (4, 5, 5) times. Finish with 4 rows of st st in B. BO all sts loosely

#### **SLEEVES (make two)**

With A CO 42 (46, 49, 52) sts. Work in st st for 6 rows. Change to B, work in pattern stitch 2 (2, 3, 4) times, decreasing 1 st at beginning and end of the row every 4 rows.

Change to B, work 4 rows in st st. Next row: \*K1, K2TOG, repeat from \* to end.

Knit 5 rows. BO loosely.

#### **FINISHING**

Join shoulder seams together. With B, pick up and knit two front placettes as follows: With RS facing and beginning at right side, pick up and knit into every 3 out of 4 stitches to end. Knit 4 rows. BO loosely. On buttonhole side, make buttonholes where desired by YO K2TOG then carry on. From placette edge to placette edge, pick up for collar as follows. With RS facing, pick up and knit into every 3 out of 4 stitches to end. Work in 1 x 1 rib for 4 rows. Work in seed stitch for 15 (17, 18, 19) rows. BO loosely. Sew up remaining seams. Sew on buttons. Weave in ends and block lightly, if desired.
