

FUN AND FRILLY GIRL'S PONCHO

*A marvelous project for a beginner knitter with the fun of something new!!
Simply make two rectangles and join them together. The self-ruffling Cha Cha
trim around the edge makes this a festive and unique poncho!*



MATERIALS

1 hank of Robin Turner Back to Basics Prima Pima
3 balls Laines du Nord Papiro
(hold one strand each of Prima Pima and Papiro together throughout)
One hank Trendsetter Cha Cha for ruffled trim.
Size 9 needle

DIRECTIONS

fits size 4 toddler

MAKE TWO IDENTICAL PIECES that are 12" by 24" each.

Pattern Stitch

Row 1: K1, P1 across row
Row 2: K all sts across row

With size 9 needle and holding two strands together as stated above, CO 48 sts. Work in pattern stitch until each piece measures 24 inches. Bind off loosely. To finish, place first piece vertically on table. Place second piece at bottom, horizontally. (This forms an L shape.) Join edges. Fold second piece toward you until the edge of that piece meets the left side of work. Fold first piece toward you until edge meets top of second piece. Join edges and weave in ends.

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CHA CHA TRIM

With RS facing use one strand of Papiro and pick up evenly along the perimeter of the poncho. Row Two: Begin carrying Cha Cha along with the Papiro, knitting into the top squares ONLY of the Cha Cha, The Papiro will stabilize the ruffle. Work 3 more rows then BO in the fourth row loosely.

CHA CHA Flower is knitted the same way, in the top square of the Cha Cha. CO 8 sts with Papiro, Next Row, knit with Cha Cha and Papiro. Knit 3 more rows, then BO. Sew edges together to form rose and attach to poncho.
