

## **MAGNIFICENT MITERED BERET**

*Addicting! This fun and easy to knit hat works up in a jiffy and yields a fashionable result! We made two different berets-one using the wild and wonderful colorways of NORO Taiyo and the other in the super soft handpaints of Malabrigo Merino Twist.*



### **MATERIALS**

Approximately 200 yds of Worsted Weight Yarn

Size 8 needles and Size 7 16" circular needle.

Gauge 4 sts to 1 inch

With Size 8 needle, CO 39 sts.

\*ROW 1 (WS): Purl

\*\*ROW 2 (RS): K1, M1, K15, SSK, K2TOG, Knit to end.

ROW 3 (WS): Knit

ROW 4 (RS): P1, M1, P15, P2TOG, P2TOG, Purl to end.

ROW 5 (WS): Knit

ROW 6 (RS): Repeat Row 2

ROW 7 (WS): Purl

Repeat from \*\* until 24 sts remain, completing Row 2. Do not turn work. Still, with RS facing, pick up 15 sts on side (39 sts). Repeat from \* 4 more times, at the end of each sequence, pick up 15 sts on the side to create a total of five miters. BO 24 sts purlwise. Sew seams of first and fifth mitered squares. With smaller circ needle, and RS facing, pick up 65 sts around perimeter of hat. Work in 1 x 1 rib for 8 rows. BO in rib. Weave in ends. Block beret gently into round circle.
