

CLASSIC FORKED CABLE **HEIRLOOM SCARF**

This classic scarf works up beautifully in our Robin Turner Gourmet Fibers' Bolivian Alpaca. You will enjoy the soft hand and blossoming effect that only this alpaca yields. Worked in a forked cable, each end of the scarf is anchored with a garter edge which keeps it from rolling. This is a project you or a loved one will treasure for years.



MATERIALS

2 skeins Robin Turner Gourmet Fibers' Bolivian Alpaca
Size 7 needles
Cable needle

DIRECTIONS

With size 7 needle, CO 39 sts. Work 10 rows garter stitch.
On Row 11, set up for cable rows as follows. K3, P3, K7, P3, K7, P3, K7, P3, K3.
Row 12: K3, K3, P7, K3, P7, K3, P7, K3, K3
Row 13: Repeat row 11.
Row 14: Repeat Row 12.
Row 15: K3, P3, C3B, K1, C3F, P3, C3B, K1, C3F, P3, C3B, K1, C3F, P3, K3
Repeat Rows 11 thru 15 until desired length.
Work 10 rows garter then BO loosely.
Weave in ends and gently block.
