

LUCK OF THE IRISH UNISEX SCARF

Knitted up in a versatile, airy rib pattern, this scarf lends itself to a handsome topcoat or breezy fall jacket. Great for both genders! When you finish your project, be sure to gently hand-wash this luscious Donegal Tweed cashmere from GBOY's exclusive Robin Turner Gourmet Fibers and towel dry to block. You'll watch your sumptuous scarf blossom as your Irish eyes are smiling!



MATERIALS

2 skeins Robin Turner Gourmet Fibers DONEGAL TWEED (six colors available)
1 size 11 needle
1 size 13 needle

PLEASE NOTE!

This pattern literally is knitted with a size 11 needle in one hand and a size 13 in the other. The 13 helps to elongate the lace pattern, giving the scarf a lofty feel and graceful drape. If you prefer using one needle size, we suggest size 11.

INSTRUCTIONS

CO 18 sts on size 11 needle.
Begin use of size 13 needle on row 1.

Row 1: K3 *YO, S1, K1, PSSO, K2; rep from * to last 3 sts, YO, S1, K1, PSSO, K1

Row 2: P3, *YO, P2TOG, P2; rep from * to last 3 sts, YO, PTOG, P1

Knit these two rows until almost all of the yarn is used. When nearing the end of the second skein, simply BO loosely on a Row 1. Hand-wash and block to showcase pattern.
