

PALM BEACH OMBRE SCARF

Using Robin Turner *Back to Basics MicroWash*, this luscious scarf can be knitted in a variety of colorways. Simply choose four even-flowing hues from the colorwheel, arrange them in the order you wish your scarf to flow and identify them by A, B, C, and D. The gradual color changes make this a fun project to knit.

Materials

3 balls Robin Turner Back to Basics MicroWash in Dark Rose (A)
3 balls Robin Turner Back to Basics MicroWash in Baby Pink (B)
3 Balls Robin Turner MicroWash in Bright White (C)
1 Ball Robin Turner MicroWash in Lime Green (D)
Size 17 needles



HOLD THREE STANDS OF YARN TOGETHER THROUGHOUT PROJECT.

Color Stripe Sequence

AAA: 10 rows
AAB: 8 rows
ABB: 8 rows
BBB: 8 rows
BBC: 8 rows
BCC: 8 rows
CCC: 8 rows
CCD: 12 rows
CCC: 8 rows
BCC: 8 rows
BBC: 8 rows
BBB: 8 rows
ABB: 8 rows
AAB: 8 rows
AAA: 10 rows

Note: to maintain an unbroken chain edge created by slipping the first stitch on every row, break and join new color strands in the body of scarf after the garter border.

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DIRECTIONS:

With 3 strands of A, CO 18 sts. Always slip first st on every row. Knit for 6 rows.
On Row 7, begin body of scarf: Slip first st, K to end of row. Row 8, Slip first st, K3,
purl to 3 sts before end of row, K3. Repeat rows 7 and 8 following color stripe sequence.

When you reach last stripe (working with 3 strands of final color), work 3 rows in
established pattern. Next row: Slip first st, knit to end of row. Repeat this row 6 more
times. BO and work in ends.

Steam the scarf to “tack” knitted border flat.
