

BACK TO BASICS **CLASSIC SEED and LEAF SCARF**

Using Robin Turner Back to Basics MicroWash, this deliciously soft scarf works up on a quick size 13 needle. Use two strands held together. In our sample, we chose an eye-catching pick and orange combo, giving the scarf a marled effect. Machine washable and dryer friendly.



MATERIALS

3 balls Robin Turner Back to Basics MicroWash in Pink (A)
3 balls Robin Turner Back to Basics MicroWash in Orange (B)
Size 13 needles

Use One Strand of A and B together throughout pattern

With size 13 needle and holding 2 strands together, cast on 24 sts.

Row 1 (RS): K1, p1 across row.

Row 2: P1, k1 across row.

Row 3: Repeat Row 1

Row 4: Repeat Row 2

Row 5: Repeat Row 1

Row 6: P1, k1, p1, k1, p across row to last 4 sts, p1, k1, p1, k1.

Maintain 4 seed st on each side of panel. Next row begins leaf pattern.

Pattern row 1 (row 7): Seed st border, p1, k3, k2tog, k1, yo, p2, yo, k1, ssk, k3, p1, border.

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Pattern row 2 and every even row of panel pattern: Border, k1, p6, k2, p6, k1.

Pattern row 3: Border, p1, k2, k2tog, k1, yo, k1, p2, k1, yo, k1, ssk, k2, p1.

Pattern row 5: Border, p1, k1, k2tog, k1, yo, k2, p2, k2, yo, k1, ssk, k1, p1.

Pattern row 7: Border, p1, k2tog, k1, yo, k3, p2, k3, yo, k1, ssk, p1.

Pattern row 8: Border, k1, p6, k2, p6, k1.

Repeat these 8 pattern rows until desired length.

End with 5 rows of seed stitch then cast off.

Weave in ends.
