

## **JAN'S FAVORITE SMOKEY MOUNTAIN SCARF**

*When Jan found this gorgeous multi-tonal delight from SWTC, a silky soft wavy menagerie of color came to life! A great project for a beginner!!*



### **MATERIALS**

2 balls SWTC Karaoke  
One pair size 11 needles.

### **WAVE PATTERN**

Row 1: K6, \*YO, K1, YO twice, KI, YO 3 times, KI, YO twice, K1, YO, K6\*; repeat between \*\* across.

Row 2: Knit straight across, dropping all YOs as you work across row.

Row 3: Knit

Row 4: Knit

Row 5: K1, \*YO, K1, YO twice, KI, YO 3 times, KI, YO twice, K1, YO, K6\*; repeat between \*\* across. You will end with a K1. (this staggers the waves.)

Row 6: Knit straight across, dropping all YOs as you work across row.

Row 7: Knit

Row 8: Knit

### **DIRECTIONS**

CO 26 stitches. Knit 4 rows. Working in Pattern stitch until scarf measures 62 inches. Work 4 more rows in garter. Bind off loosley. Scarf really looks nice after blocking lightly with a steam iron. (Note—Can make a wider scarf using a multiple of 10 plus 6 stitches.)
