

## **GREAT BALLS AND SQUIGGLES!**

*This was one fun scarf to make—and even more fun to wear! Using just one skein of Pagewood Farm’s Giant Purls and a complementary hand-dyed DK weight yarn for the squiggles, you will create a truly one of a kind conversation piece!*



### **MATERIALS**

One Skein Pagewood Farm’s Giant Purls  
One skein (200 yds) DK weight hand-dyed yarn  
Size 15 and 9 needles

### **SEED STITCH**

Row 1: K1, P1, K1, P1, K1, P1, K1, P1, K1, P1, K1.  
Row 2: K1, P1, K1, P1, K1, P1, K1, P1, K1, P1, K1.

With Purls and size 15 needle, CO 11 sts. Work in seed stitch pattern until just approx 3 yards remain, making sure to gently push felted balls to one side. BO loosely in pattern.

Adorn by tying squiggles on to right side—as many as you desire!

Lightly steam to block into shape.

### **SQUIGGLES**

With size 9 needle, cast on 15sts. Knit in the front and back of each stitch. Bind off purlwise. We made these in varying lengths, with some squiggles we CO as many as 25 sts. Have fun and squiggle liberally—it makes it!
