

## **ANNE'S THROUGH THICK 'N THIN SCARF OR SHAWL**



### FINISHED MEASUREMENTS:

SCARF: APPROXIMATELY 8" X 60"

SHAWL: APPROXIMATELY 16" X 54"

GAUGE: APPROXIMATELY 9 STITCHES AND 10 ROWS TO 4 INCHES IN PATTERN. PLEASE NOTE THAT THERE ARE MANY DIFFERENT COMBINATIONS THAT WILL MAKE THIS PIECE BEAUTIFUL AND THE GAUGE WILL BE SLIGHTLY DIFFERENT FOR EACH ONE. THIS IS JUST A GUIDELINE AND NOT AS IMPORTANT AS IT DOES NOT HAVE TO "FIT" EXACTLY.

### MATERIALS:

1 - (MC) LILY CHIN TRIBECA (25% MOHAIR, 43% WOOL, 17% VISCOSE, 15% POLYESTER 153 YDS/ 50 GRAM BALL) COLOR 1272 SOFT CELERY

1 - (CC) MALABRIGO AQUARELLA ( HAND PAINTED PURE WOOL 65 YARDS/ SKEIN) COLOR MALDONADO

IF MAKING THE SHAWL YOU WILL NEED APPROXIMATELY 230 YARDS OF MOHAIR.

1 24" OR LONGER #17 CIRCULAR NEEDLE

FOR SCARF CAST ON 25 STITCHES IN CC, FOR SHAWL CAST ON 45 STITCHES IN CC. ALL OTHER DIRECTIONS ARE THE SAME FOR BOTH ITEMS EXCEPT THAT THE SHAWL CAN BE A BIT SHORTER THAN THE SCARF.

PATTERN:

ROW 1: (RS): SWITCH TO MC, K.

ROW 2: (WS): P.

ROW 3: (RS) K.

ROW 4: (WS) P.

ROW 5: (RS) SWITCH TO CC, CARRYING IT LOOSELY UP THE EDGE OF THE WORK; K;

ROW 6: (RS) SLIDE STITCHES TO OTHER END OF CIRCULAR NEEDLE. PICK UP MC; K.

ROW 7: (WS) P.

ROW 8: (RS) K.

ROW 9: (WS) P.

ROW 10: (WS) SLIDE WORK TO OTHER END OF CIRCULAR NEEDLE. PICK UP CC, CARRYING IT LOOSELY UP THE EDGE OF THE WORK; P.

REPEAT THESE 10 ROWS 12 TIMES OR UNTIL YOU REACH THE LENGTH YOU WANT. END WITH EITHER A ROW 4 OR ROW 9 BEFORE BINDING OFF LOOSELY.
