

BOLIVIAN ALPACA TRELLIS SCARF

The incredibly soft hand of Robin Turner Gourmet Fibers' Bolivian Alpaca will have you wishing you could knit this scarf in every vibrant color. With the highest micron count available in the industry, this baby belly alpaca will just get softer as you wear it. Try this unusual and decorative pattern! One skein scarf is 6 by 50".



MATERIALS

One skein Robin Turner Gourmet Fibers' Bolivian Alpaca
size 7 needle

TRELLIS PATTERN

Row 1: K3, Purl across row until last three sts, K3.

Row 2: (RS): K5, *YO, K3, pass 3rd st on right hand needle over first 2 sts; repeat from * to last 4 sts, K4.

Row 3: K3, Purl across row until last 3 sts, K3.

Row 4: (RS): K4, *K3, pass 3rd st on right hand needle over first 2 sts, YO, repeat from * to last 5 sts, K5. (Be sure not to forget last YO!)

CO 33 sts. Knit 6 rows. Begin trellis pattern sequence and repeat until scarf measures 49 inches from the beginning. End after completing Row 1. Knit 6 rows then bind off loosley. Lightly steam to block.
