

MYRA'S LITTLE SWEETHEART SWEATER



Sizes – Children's 2 (4, 6) years old

Materials – 4 (5, 6) balls RT Back-to-Basics Microwash
Size 9 US needles
Tapestry needle
4 buttons

Gauge – 3 sts and 4 rows = 1 inch

Pattern Stitch

Row 1 – Purl 2, Knit 4 across

Row 2 – Knit 2. Purl 4 across

Row 3 – Purl across row

Row 4 – Repeat Row 2

Row 5 – Repeat Row 1

Row 6 – Repeat Row 2

Back – Cast on 42 (48, 54) sts. Start with Row 1, and work up until you have 6 (7, 8) purred ridges. Armhole – Place marker at each side of armhole. Work in pattern until armhole measures 5 ½ (6, 6 ½) inches. Place stitches on holder.

Front – work same as back until after Armhole markers are placed.. Work across 12 stitches, place marker, knit 18 (24, 30) sts, place marker, finish row. Work first and last stitches in pattern, and knit center stitches every row. Work 1 pattern repeat. Divide work in half, and continue working two sides until pieces measures same as back. Do 3-needle bind off on 12 stitches of each side of back and fronts.

Collar - Starting at center front, continue to knit the remaining stitches for collar. Knit 3 rows even. Increase 3 stitches evenly spaced around. Repeat these 4 rows twice more, knit 2 rows even. Bind off loosely.

Sleeves – Pick up 54 (58, 62) stitches from armhole marker around to other marker. Keeping in pattern, decrease 1 stitch each side of every 4th row 12 (13, 14) times. Continue in pattern until 7 purl ridges are complete. Work 6 rows more. Bind off n pattern.

Sew up side and sleeve seams.
