

COTTAGE CHIC DECORATOR THROW

Using all the thick and thin novelties and wools from the Pagewood Farm collection, this cozy, funky throw knitted up easy and quick over a basic stockinette stitch. Gently pull the flowers, fauna and fun through to the front side for an optimum effect.



MATERIALS for finished size 48 by 60" throw

One 36" size 17 needle

Size K crochet hook

We used the following yarns and colorways from the Pagewood Farm collection. There are other great colors from which to choose to custom tailor your Cottage Chic Throw!

A=Handspun Bouquet in Navy

B=Rustic Spun in Kiwi

C= Rustic Spun in Navy

D= **HOLD 2 STRANDS TOGETHER**-Kissi Bird of Paradise & Kissi Marine Girl

E= Flora in Forest

F=Bling in Kiwi

G=Bling in Forest

With C, loosely CO 73 sts on size 17 needle. Knit 3 rows in garter stitch. The following pattern is the color sequence we used but change it up to your preference. The more whimsical the better!

BEGIN PATTERN SEQUENCE

HERE

D= 4 rows st st

E=2 rows garter

B= K1, YO, K2TOG; repeat to end of
row

B=1 row purl

D=4 rows st st

A=2 rows st st

B=2 rows garter

B=2 rows st st

D=4 rows st st

E=2 rows st st

C=2 rows st st

B=4 rows st st

F=2 rows st st

C=4 rows st st

D=4 rows st st

A=2 rows st st

B=4 rows st st

F=2 rows st st

C=2 rows st st

D=4 rows st st

A=4 rows st st

B=4 rows st st

D=4 rows st st

C=4 rows st st

G=4 rows st st

E=2 rows st st

B=4 rows st st

A=2 rows st st

F=2 rows st st

D= 4 rows st st

C=4 rows st st

E=2 rows st st

G=4 rows st st

A=2 rows st st

B=4 rows st st

D=4 rows st st

G=2 rows st st

A=2 rows st st

E=2 rows st st

F=4 rows st st

B= 4 rows st st

B=1 row purl

A=2 rows st st

D=4 rows st st

B=K1, YO, K2TOG; repeat to end of
row

B=1 row purl

D=4 rows st st

C=3 rows garter

BO loosely in garter

FINISHING

On each selvedge, you will secure all loose ends by gently weaving them in. Then, with RS facing, use B to single crochet up the side, then Reverse Single Crochet (crab stitch) back to the starting point. Repeat on the other side. Before tying off, be sure that crocheted edges are loose. Steam into shape and cuddle up!
