

GO GATORS!

BABY CARRIAGE COVER or STADIUM BLANKET

Wear it Loud and Proud, Florida Fans!! This easy to crochet blanket can be whipped up faster than a first down. Make it in any size as the formula is a cinch. Root for our team or pick your school's colors!



MATERIALS

(for Carriage Cover—finished size 30 x 32 inches before fringe)

1 Balls Amity Worsted in Royal Blue (A)	Three Rows
2 balls Amity Worsted in White (B)	Two Rows
1 Ball Amity Worsted in Orange (C)	Three Rows

Size H crochet hook

DIRECTIONS

With A, loosely chain 151 stitches. Working in double crochet, chain 2, skip first st, double crochet 9, * chain 10, double crochet 10, repeat from * to end of row. Work in this pattern for two more rows. Change to B and repeat pattern for 2 rows. Change to C and repeat pattern for 3 rows. Change to B and repeat pattern for 2 rows. Change back to A and continue this same pattern and color sequence until desired length. Finish sequence with 2 rows of Color A.

FINISHING

While working last (or third) row of color A, double crochet across until you get to chain 10 section. Weave “chains” up from the bottom as you would if you were to pick up a dropped stockinette knitted stitch. Double crochet three times into chain to secure the upward woven stitches. Continue in this manner across the top edge of the work. Fringe liberally with left over yarn, securing any unjoined chained edges.

Pattern is worked in multiple of 10 plus 1 so you can make any size your heart desires!
